Alaska Railroad Corporation Works to Comply With New TSA Regulations

Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations going into effect on Sunday, May 23 require Alaska Railroad passengers 18 years of age or older to present either:

1. A photo ID issued by a government authority, or
2. Two other forms of ID, at least one of which shall be issued by a government authority.

“With the help of Alaska Railroad Corporation Police & Security we are developing systems to comply with the regulations while minimizing disruptions to our guests,” Adrie Setten, Passenger Operations Director, said.

A TSA pilot program in New Carrollton, Maryland is testing the feasibility and impact of further screening processes. The regulations, which also apply to AMTRAK, come on the heels of March terrorist attacks in Madrid, Spain.

“Local TSA personnel have provided assistance in complying with this Security Directive,” ARRC Special Agent Jim Adams said. “We have no information indicating plans to attack the Alaska Railroad, but remain vigilant at all times.”
