Limited Train Traffic Resumes Through Moody Tunnel

ANCHORAGE-Alaska Railroad train operations resumed Thursday evening with limited freight service north and south after crews stabilized Moody Tunnel from further slides. Full freight and passenger service will resume on Friday.

Railroad crews have been working around-the-clock for more than 48-hours to repair the tunnel and prevent further slides. Steel support frames now replace the damaged timber frames to stabilize and support the tunnel and crews will continue to make minor repairs throughout the evening.

Earlier this week, a 12-foot section of timber support frames in Moody Tunnel was damaged. Work to repair the damage caused a rockslide that shut down the track and tunnel to train traffic.
