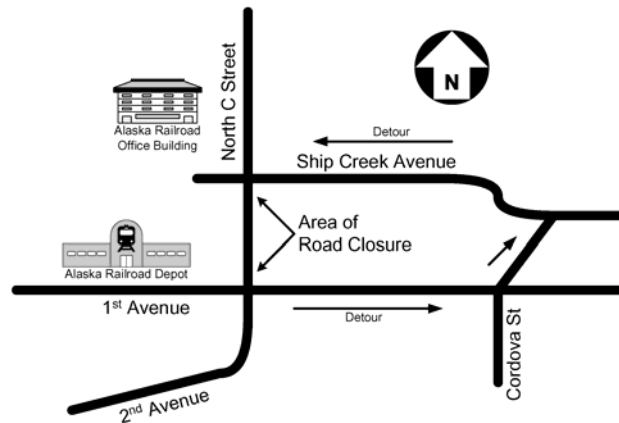
Railroad to close North C Street for 2 weeks for construction

Closure necessary for work on Ship Creek Intermodal project

ANCHORAGE, Alaska – The Alaska Railroad (ARRC) will close North ‘C’ Street to vehicle traffic between 1st Avenue and Ship Creek Avenue, beginning Monday, October 1, 2007, for approximately two weeks. The closure is necessary to carry out construction activities related to ARRC’s Ship Creek Intermodal Transportation Center (ITC) project.

Construction activity includes installing electrical and railroad signal conduit and wiring, earthwork for track and utilities, constructing storm drainage structures and piping, and installing the railroad crossing panels. Motorists can use the Cordova Street crossing as a detour during construction (*see map below*).
