Flooding Concerns Halt Passenger Rail Traffic at Denali

ANCHORAGE, Alaska – The Alaska Railroad Corporation (ARRC) has stopped passenger train activity north of Denali Park due to flooding concerns near Nenana. At this time, no flooding has occurred and there is no damage to ARRC track but water levels continue to rise.

Today's southbound Denali Star from Fairbanks will continue to Anchorage as planned. The northbound Denali Star which runs between Anchorage and Fairbanks will stop in Denali and passengers will continue north by bus.

As a precaution, passengers on tomorrow's (Thursday July 31) southbound train will travel, by bus, between Fairbanks and Denali and continue by train to Talkeetna and Anchorage. The northbound Denali Star is expected to run as scheduled.

Freight traffic will continue normal service. ARRC crews continue to monitor the Tanana and Nenana Rivers.
