## **UPDATE 7/31: Flooding in Nenana Waterfront Halts Passenger Service**

ANCHORAGE, Alaska – Flooding in Nenana has stopped Alaska Railroad (ARRC) passenger operations between Denali Park and Fairbanks for a second day. Flooding in both the Tanana and the Nenana Rivers continues to cause problems and is being closely monitored by ARRC crews.

Today's southbound Denali Star passenger train from Fairbanks will continue to Anchorage as planned. The northbound Denali Star which runs between Anchorage and Fairbanks will stop in Denali and passengers will continue north to Fairbanks by bus.

Passengers on tomorrow morning's (August 1) southbound train will travel by bus between Fairbanks and Denali and continue by train to Talkeetna and Anchorage. Depending on conditions, we hope the northbound Denali Star passenger train will run as scheduled to Fairbanks.
