ARRC Mainline Open Between Talkeetna and Hurricane

ANCHORAGE, Alaska –Alaska Railroad Corporation (ARRC) freight and passenger service has resumed between Anchorage and Fairbanks. ARRC crews completed repairs between Talkeetna and Hurricane late Wednesday night.

Water and ice flows from the Susitna River damaged the track and railbed between ARRC milepost 238 and 254. Freight service between Anchorage and Fairbanks was halted while ARRC crews completed repairs.
