## **Man Dies After Being Struck by Locomotive**

ANCHORAGE, Alaska – At approximately 2 p.m., a 42-year-old unidentified male located on the track bed was struck and killed by a south-bound Alaska Railroad (ARRC) passenger train near ARRC milepost 210. The Alaska State Troopers and ARRC Special Agents are investigating the incident.

Initial reports indicate the man was trying to retrieve a dog located on the mainline at Montana Creek. The train crew blew the horn and went into an emergency braking procedure but was unable to stop. The man was struck and thrown clear of the track.

Next of kin is being notified. Further information will be released as it becomes available.
