Construction Activity to Increase in the Ship Creek Area

ANCHORAGE, Alaska – The Alaska Railroad Corporation advises visitors to the Ship Creek area of increased activity along 1st Avenue and North C Street. Summer passenger train and construction activity is expected to hit full stride by mid-May and will continue through September.

Drivers and pedestrians are asked to exercise caution while in the Ship Creek area, obey all traffic signs, and be mindful of the work crews and heavy equipment operating in the area. Expect delays when transiting the area.

Construction pertains to Phase 1 and 2 of the Ship Creek Intermodal Facility with work expected to continue for the better part of the spring/summer season. In addition, from North C Street to Cordova Street along 1st Avenue, work continues on the Historic Freight restoration project.
